


GOLFER FOURSOME \$5,000

Harnessing the Power

Humans recognized early on that horses develop and maintain relationships with people. Through time, horses have fascinated and encouraged humans to reach their highest degree of success and survival. This difficult to define yet undeniable bond between horses and people encompasses life's physical, mental, and spiritual components.

Mr. Billy Jack Barrett and Mrs. Jeanne Springer founded the program in 2009 at the U.S. Air Force Academy. The program harnesses the "horse power" bond by connecting struggling heroes to horses – all at no expense to the participants or the U.S. taxpayers. Word spread quickly amongst the Colorado military and first-responder communities of the real results our nation's bravest find through the Remount Method.

A legend in the cowboy and horse community and a U.S. Army veteran from the Vietnam era, Mr. Barrett – the last horse buyer for Fort Carson's 4/12 Cavalry program and over 40 years as the manager of the U.S. Air Force Academy Equestrian Center – noted the healing effect that horses had on combat-wounded veterans. Through his work in the horse industry, Mr. Barrett was acquainted with Audie Murphy (the most decorated U.S. soldier of WWII); General A.P. Clarke (WWII prisoner of war and former Superintendent of the U.S. Air Force Academy); General Macke Steinhoff (Germany's leading fighter pilot ace in WWII); and countless other distinguished combat veterans.
