History

Remount Foundation (RF) is a Colorado registered and IRS-recognized 501(c)3 charitable organization that helps active duty military, veterans of all eras, and their family members recover from physical and psychological trauma through the use of horses. Our Equine-Assisted Philosophy (EAP) approach to suicide intervention and prevention began when Co-Founders Jeanne Springer and Billy Jack Barrett witnessed the transformative, healing power between equines and troops returning from combat. Founded in 2009, RF's program is FREE to participants. Remount operates out of the U.S. Air Force Academy's Equestrian Center in Colorado Springs at no cost to U.S. taxpayers.

RF Method

The Remount Method, the heart of our program developed by our Program Director Jeanne Springer, is a one-of-kind toolset customized to meet each participant at their comfort level on their lifepath to healing. No other entities offer the breadth and scope of the RF program.

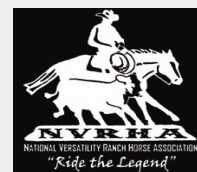
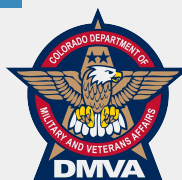
- Based on a military installation
- Herd of horses available for use, on a 1,000-acre facility with pastures, arenas, round pens, and trails
- Serve a substantial number of participants simultaneously
- RF Method is a veteran peer mentor program
- Facility resources allow for diverse programming and interaction

We offer EAP in several formats: in group events of 2-10 participants and during tailored one-on-one peer mentorship sessions. RF Family Play Days utilizes nature and movement to encourage exploration, sensory stimulation, fine and gross motor development, and communication in equine-focused interaction and play for neurodiverse diagnoses and to mitigate a broad spectrum of life trauma. Lastly, a key component of our EAP exercises includes resilience-building HeartMath® techniques, which teach emotional and physiological self-regulation techniques.

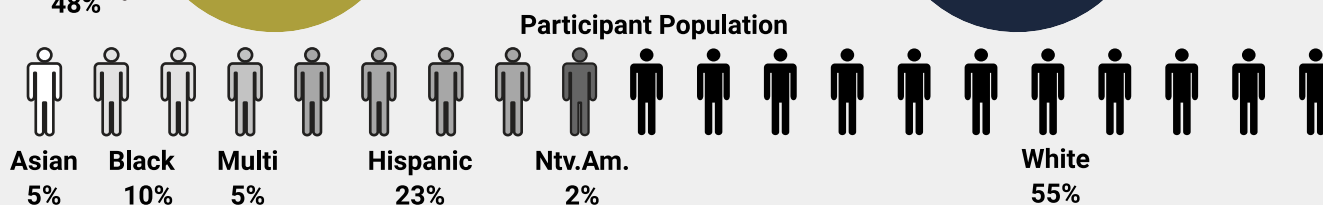
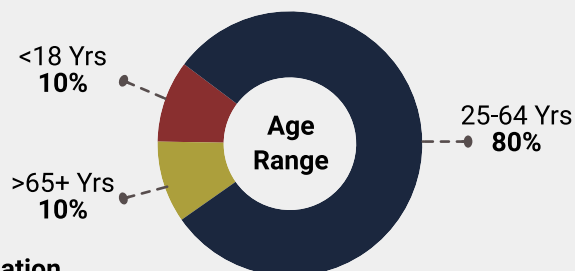
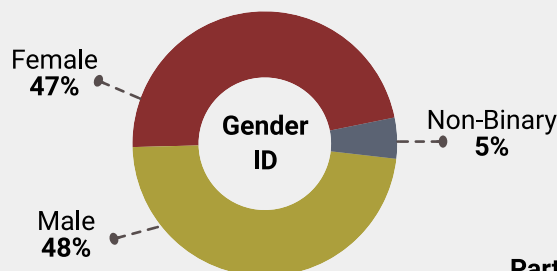
Partners

Remount Foundation has a strong record of partnering with government organizations to help address mental health needs, substance use disorder, and the suicide crisis among Colorado's active duty and veterans. RF works with military installations and veteran-aligned behavioral health clinics along the Front Range, the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), the VA Vet Center in Colorado Springs, and Veterans Service Organizations (VSOs) in Colorado. These behavioral health clinics, VSOs, the Colorado Springs VA, and the Colorado Springs VA Vet Center are the primary referral sources of Remount Foundation's participants.

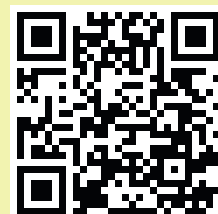
